Signs of infection include tree canopy dieback, yellowing, and browning of leaves. Most trees die within 2 to 4 years of becoming infested. The Tree Doctor is up-to-date on the latest scientific information about this pest and warns that there is a lot of misinformation out there. Up to 14% of all trees in Western New York are ash trees. Owners of ash trees should take action now to protect their trees.
