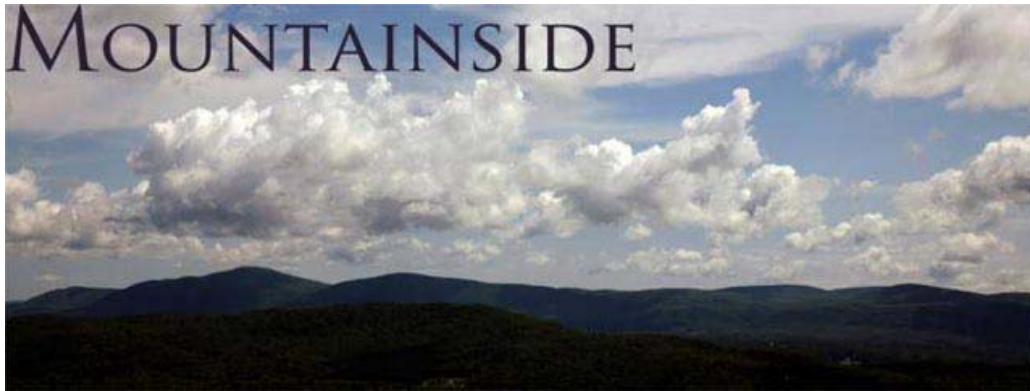


Innovative Drug Rehab Facility Offers Cocaine Addiction Treatment
